

KEY QUESTIONS to support assessment in Art (Key Stage 2)

Pupils working at Level 1

in ***Evaluating and Developing Work***

should be able to answer these questions well:

- What do you think about your piece of art work? What do you feel about it?
- What about other pieces of work you have looked at?

Pupils working at Level 2

in ***Exploring and developing ideas***

should be able to answer these questions well:

- What art materials and art techniques have you been using? What did you think of them?
- What do you want to do for your piece of art work?
- What do you want it to be about?

Pupils working at Level 2

in ***Investigating and Making Art, Craft and Design***

should be able to answer these questions well:

- Tick the list to show which materials and art techniques you used.
- Why did you choose these materials?

Pupils working at Level 2

in ***Evaluating and Developing Work***

should be able to answer these questions well:

- Describe some of the differences between your piece of work and other people's.
- Which parts of your piece of work do you think could be made better? How could you do this?

Pupils working at Level 3

in ***Exploring and developing ideas***

should be able to answer these questions well:

- What observations did you record? How did you do this?
- What materials did you choose to use? What information helped you to make a good choice?

Pupils working at Level 3

in ***Investigating and Making Art, Craft and Design***

should be able to answer these questions well:

- Explain what you were trying to represent in your artwork.
- Describe some of the features you were trying to represent.

Pupils working at Level 3

in ***Evaluating and Developing Work***

should be able to answer these questions well:

- Describe what you have done and what you have learned in this art project.
- How is your artwork similar to other people's?
- How is your artwork different?
- Describe some links between your work and the work of artists you have studied.

Pupils working at Level 4

in ***Exploring and developing ideas***

should be able to answer these questions well:

- What information about visual and tactile qualities of materials did you record in your sketchbook? How did you do this?
- What information helped you develop ideas for your artwork?
- What information helped you choose suitable materials and art techniques that would be best?

Pupils working at Level 4

in ***Investigating and Making Art, Craft and Design***

should be able to answer these questions well:

- What features of "X" (the "thing" your artwork is about) affected your choice of materials and art techniques?
- What materials and art techniques did you use? How did you combine materials and techniques?
- Explain how you combined and organised shape, form, and space, and applied colour, tone, pattern and texture in your artwork.

Pupils working at Level 4

in ***Evaluating and Developing Work***

should be able to answer these questions well:

- How did your work develop?
- Describe some of the different ideas, art techniques and ways of working you and others' used in this art project. What do you think of these?
- Think about the art techniques and ways of working you and others' used in this art project. How did these relate to the **context** in which the work was made and the **purpose** of the work.
- What connections (links) can you think of between the ideas behind your own work and those of others, including artists you have studied? Describe as many as you can think of.
- How did you modify and improve your work as you were doing it so that it turned out as I wanted it to?

Pupils working at Level 5

in ***Exploring and developing ideas***

should be able to answer these questions well:

- What information from your research did you choose to help you to develop your work? Why did you select this information?

Pupils working at Level 5

in ***Investigating and Making Art, Craft and Design***

should be able to answer these questions well:

- What features of "X" (the "thing" your artwork is about) affected your choice of materials and art techniques?
- What materials and art techniques did you use? How did you combine materials and techniques?
- Explain how you combined and organised shape, form, and space, and applied colour, tone, pattern and texture in your artwork.

Pupils working at Level 5

in ***Evaluating and Developing Work***

should be able to answer these questions well:

- Describe and explain the ideas, methods and techniques you used to create your own art work. What different ideas, methods and techniques did others use? How did the artists' choices relate to the purpose and context of the artwork.
- How did you adapt and refine your work to reflect your view of its purpose and meaning?
